

EARTH DAY RECYCLED ART CONTEST

SUBMISSION DEADLINE: APRIL 20, 2015 | COLLEGE STUDENT ART CONTEST

The City of Sioux Falls in partnership with the Washington Pavilion, Millennium Recycling, Ecomaniacs and the South Dakota Sierra Club, is proud to offer a contest highlighting the artistic talents of college students in the Sioux Falls area. All entries will be displayed and judged during the opening reception at the Washington Pavilion on Earth Day, April 22nd 2015. Six finalists will be chosen and displayed in the lobby of the Washington Pavilion from April 25 through May 30, 2015. Finalist entries will be awarded prizes including gift cards to student's college bookstore, Washington Pavilion memberships, State Park entry passes, a refurbished laptop, and a solar backpack charger.

GUIDELINES:

1. Open to all college students enrolled in South Dakota schools.
2. Only one artwork may be submitted per student.
3. Artwork must be inspired by the theme "Energy Efficiency"
4. Artwork must be composed of at least 90% single stream materials:
 - a. Plastic bottles, tubs and jugs
 - b. Glass bottles and jars
 - c. Steel and tin cans
 - d. Aluminum cans, trays, pans and foil
 - e. Milk and juice cartons
 - f. Office paper, newspaper, junk mail, envelopes
 - g. Magazines, inserts, brochures, catalogs, phone books, paperback books
 - h. Corrugated cardboard, brown paper bags
 - i. Paperboard boxes (i.e. cereal/pasta boxes), paper egg cartons

5. Artwork size must be no larger than 24x20 and 24 inches high.
6. All entries must include two (2) completed copies of the contest entry forms.
 - a. Please print clearly and be sure the information is complete.
 - b. Attach one (1) entry form to the BACK of the work of art
 - c. Email one (1) copy of the entry form to visualartscenter@WashingtonPavilion.org.
7. All artwork must be delivered to the Washington Pavilion no later than April 20, 2015 at 5:00 p.m.

When the display ends, finalist students may pick up their artwork from the Pavilion (by June 6).
